Testimony by Catherine Turcer, Common Cause Ohio Before the Ohio Redistricting Commission September 22, 2023 Deer Creek State Park



My name is Catherine Turcer and I am the executive director of Common Cause Ohio. I have been advocating for fair districts and fair elections since the late 1990s. I am here today to encourage you all to review previous testimony and explore the state legislative maps that have been proposed to the Ohio Redistricting Commission.


In 2021 702 Ohions testified at the regional hearings. They urged the commission to create a truly transparent process, to focus on keeping communities together, and highlighted that they wanted to participate in truly meaningful elections. We are here today because the Ohio Supreme Court repeatedly sent the Commission back to the drawing board and then the Commission delayed for over a year. Today, we are in a state park; in 2021, there were hearings in Akron, Cleveland, Columbus, Dayton, Lima, Mansfield, Rio Grande, Toledo, Youngstown, and Zanesville. I say this because you are missing an opportunity to truly hear from the public. Many of you weren't part of the Ohio Redistricting Commission for the first regional hearings and I urge you to take a close look at the state legislative district proposals submitted by Fair Districts Ohio and the Ohio Citizens Redistricting Commission. Please spend some time exploring the community maps that were submitted previously and are available on <u>Districtr.org</u>.


Hundreds of Ohioans attended hearings in 2021 & 2022, eager to share their thoughts and hopes for Ohio's maps. But looking around the room today you see a different story. Because of the foot dragging, backroom mapmaking, and repeated redraws, many Ohioans are so frustrated that they've given up. They don't believe that you will listen to them or produce fair maps that abide by the letter and law of our redistricting rules. That doesn't mean that you should give up on your oath to abide by the Ohio Constitution. I remind you that 71% of Ohio voters supported amendments to the Ohio Constitution to do away with exactly the kind of gerrymandering we see in the maps under consideration by this Commission today. I strongly encourage you to truly deliberate—in public—over the district lines. Please discuss and debate the merits and take the time necessary to create district lines that keep communities together and do not unduly favor one political party over another.

Officially Proposed on 9/20/23: Ohio House




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


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




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


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Ohio Communities of Interest from 2020 Block Groups Updated 9/3/2021, 10:35:44 AM



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


Ohio House Districts Proposed by GOP Members with BIPOC Information













