Attached are two (2) exhibits on a Proposed Plan to Redistrict the State of Ohio to fifteen (15) US Congressional Districts using the US Census Bureau August 12, 2021 population estimates.

The first exhibit is a narrative on the rules, lists the New Districts by county populations, and a provides an overall summary.

The second exhibit shows a Pictorial Diagram on how the Districts were assigned, and the new District boundaries on a map of the State of Ohio.

The premise was to minimize the number of county splits. This plan splits only the three (3) largest populated counties, and matches each to an adjacent county to form a New District. The present map splits twenty-four (24) counties. Each County is a unique geographical and political subdivision of the State of Ohio and its integrity should be maintained. Many counties remained in their present Districts.

Most counties have irregular boundaries and a smooth demarcation line can not be drawn even between two or more counties and therefore the New District boundaries are non linear and are irregular.
